The Key Award is for special recognition to 4-H members who have shown consistent growth in their 4-H program, who have developed their leadership ability, and who have been helpful members in their club and community. For youth in Grades 11 and 12 who have completed at least three years of 4-H and one year of junior leadership. This award is based on the evaluation of the member's total record (projects, activities, leadership and personal development, and senior 4-H program.
